Asif Rizvi, B. Tech(Mechanical) and Mushtaque Ahmed, B.Tech(Electronics) from the 2006 batch, both of them in ISRO have also worked for the development of PSLV-C11 rocket which carried Chandrayaan- 1 in to space from the Satish Dhawan Space Centre.

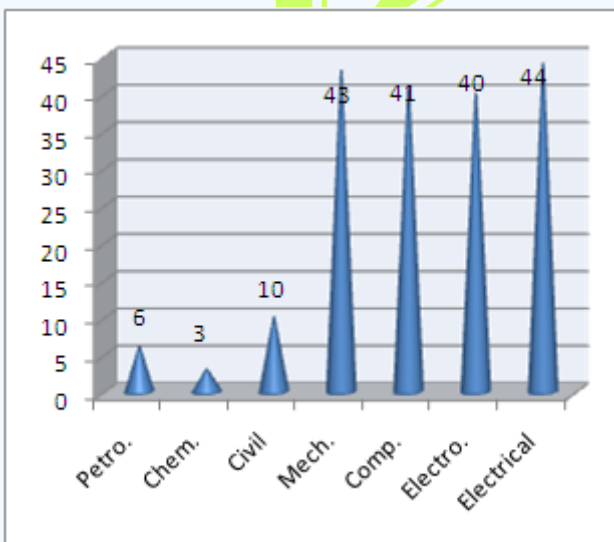
